

Monumental Lawn

Available at Gungahlin Cemetery, a Monumental Lawn allotment is a lawn grave, with memorialisation by way of a small headstone on the concrete beam at the head of the grave.

Interments can take place seven days of the week. Graves are dug to double depth. Most graves can be dug to triple depth, which incurs an additional fee.

A headstone is not included in the cost of the allotment. Documentation will be issued post-burial and will include a list of local stonemasons who can arrange headstone construction.

Cleaning and maintenance of the monument is the responsibility of the family. Canberra Memorial Parks is responsible for the maintenance of the cemetery grounds only.

In the interim period between the burial and memorialisation, a temporary grave marker will be provided.

Although fresh flowers are permitted at the grave, Canberra Memorial Parks discourages any placement of personal, valuable or sentimental items in the area.
