

Vault Allotment

Available at Gungahlin and Woden Cemeteries, a Vault allotment is a headstone grave that has a sealed, double-depth, concrete crypt installed within the allotment. The memorialisation is by way of a full monument covering the entire length of the grave.

Pre-installed vaults can be purchased. Alternatively, subject to site approval by Canberra Memorial Parks, a vault can be installed in your preferred position, which incurs an additional fee.

Interments can take place seven days of the week.

A monument is not included in the allotment fees. Documentation will be issued post-burial and will

include a list of local stonemasons who can arrange monument construction.

Cleaning and maintenance of the monument is the responsibility of the family. Canberra Memorial Parks is responsible for the maintenance of the cemetery grounds only.

In the interim period between the burial and memorialisation, a temporary grave marker will be provided.

Canberra Memorial Parks discourages any placement of personal, valuable or sentimental items on the site.
